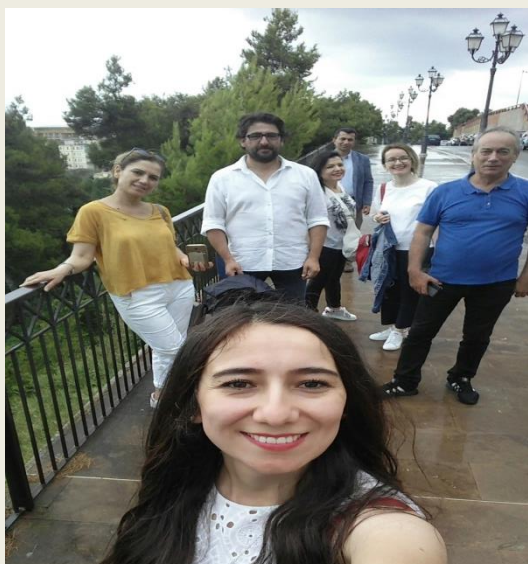
All partners will send photos, activities links, posters, samples of brochures to Italian partner for e-book.
