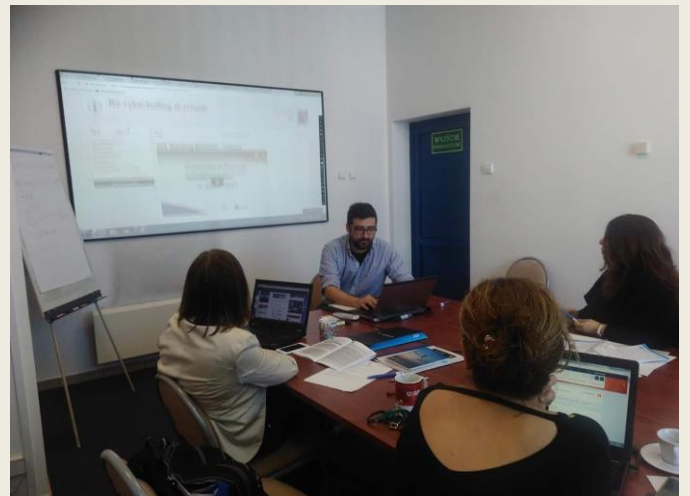
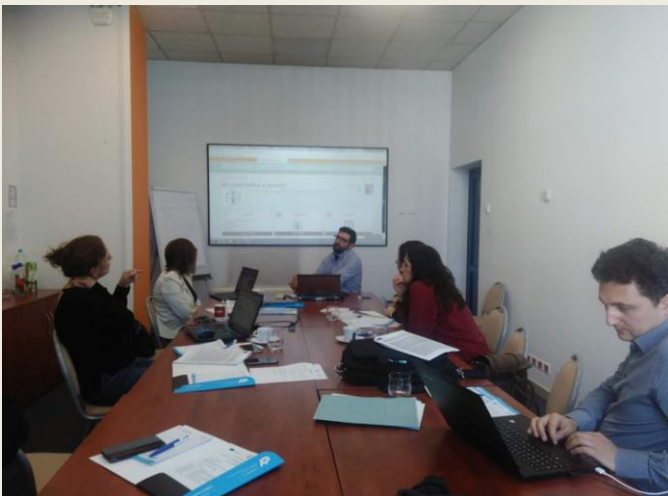


The 4<sup>th</sup> Transnational Project Meeting “ No Cyberbullying At The School ” Erasmus+ project took place two days.

**21:03.2018:** Arrival of the city, “Rzeszow”

**22.03.2018:**

- The partners from Italy, Portugal, Poland and Turkey came together in the meeting venue
- After a short presentation and introduction, the partners were introduced the timetable of the meeting.
- The Polish team presented the details that they conducted a pilot and core studies among group of pupils to understand the situations in the schools about bullying actions. They applied surveys to the participants



-The results were presented in detail and it has shown that the effect of all studies and the dissemination Works have decreased the amount of bullying actions.

- Project web site was examined and it was decided that necessary precautions should have taken to increase the amount of users. Partners agreed that putting a COUNTER would be nice to understand how many people visit the webpage from which part of the World. Italian Partner was explained to fulfill the necessary parts that the Project website has and AMEM, Directorate of Ankara Province of National Education, was asked to deal with the Turkish version of the project webpage.
